

MHSIP VI Conference Call – 8/17/00

Next Call September 28 12-2.

E-mail Ted L. changes to the draft write-up of July meeting but 8/25.

MASHPD members met Monday and took recommendations from children's group. Commissioners voted to add to PTF framework: % of kids living in family settings; % of kids in therapeutic foster care; % of kids receiving services in school or home-based.

Same states working on the kids survey will work on these, including Steve Davis.

Cultural competency measures - WICHE report on cultural competency on their web site. Commissioners recommended looking at access by different ethnic groups. (John P is already collecting this for MHSIP 6.)

MH block grant 2002 reporting:

Marie: Eugene Wolf (sp?) is the new BG chief. Working closely with NASHPD (and Joyce Berry) to develop Uniform Reporting System (URS), especially domain 4 and 5. Keep 2002 application the same for 12 criteria and add addendum for URS.

*get data domains from Marie if we don't have them.

Putting together OMB packet for 2002.

Penetration Rate:

John – start collecting FY2000 with three-way cross tabs of age, race, sex.

Family/Kid Survey:

Rand K. – VA just finished survey, response rate, N=500, 32%. CT's response rate was 28%. Children's Roundtable is interested in survey.

Costs:

Nancy – (CO, Missouri, Arkansas, CT, Utah, WA, NY participating) Collecting fy99 & 00 data.

*I told her I would check with Steve about OK submitting data.

Contact within 7 days – John and Tracy

Do the same cross tabs as John P.

* Get the total number of states that will be able to participate in the next 5 or 6 months.

* Send out the definition on list serv and to Ted L. by the end of the month.

Readmissions within 30 days (and 180 day) – data from 11 states, only looking at state hospitals.

Linking Consumer to Physical Health Services – Deb

The latest ECHO survey does not have the same items as any MHSIP VI states are using.

Employment (Utah, OK, NY, Nancy and Steve Davis) – need a group leader.

Living Situation (AR, NY, WA, Ted L., Eva, SC, CO, Utah)

Mortality – Craig (OK, AR, Bruce Dembling, Eva, MS, John P., VeeJay, SC)
Several states are getting into matching data. Mortality data is changing to IC9 hand codes. 10-11 states can report.

Criminal Justice:

LOF – Mary, putting together framework of symptomatology

Recovery – VeeJay on vacation, he has not sent out survey because he has to send out to work group first – 52 item instrument.

Reduced Substance Abuse - Jack Wackowitz

Will get out questionnaire to work group next week. Children's work group recommended looking at "% of kids screened for SA use."

Policy Involvement/Development – Planners will fill out a one-time survey. Use the NASHPD measure? Will need to be broken out to 2 indicators to look at consumers and family members.

ORYX Measure – Ted NASHPD will give data to states' central offices, get data in Oct.
